Bristol Redistro raises money and gives it to people and groups working to create a more just, equal and sustainable world.

We believe those most affected by inequality should be supported to create their own solutions. You don't have to be formally registered, e.g. as a charity or CIC, to apply. You could just have an idea to tackle an issue you're affected by.

We have a short application and you can apply in writing, video, voice note or over the phone. When you apply you are invited to be part of the decision-making process.

Funding criteria

1. **Set up and led by a community most affected by inequality** (e.g. women, non-binary, LGBTQ+, working class, disabled, migrant, refugee, Black and racially minoritised people)
2. **Led by working class people** (e.g. experience of living in social or insecure housing, receiving benefits, in low paid work, not expecting an inheritance or to be able to buy a home)
3. **Based in Bristol**
4. If a group, must be **non-profit** with an **annual income under £10,000** (e.g. the amount your group has raised through fundraising)



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
